International Dressage and Show Jumping Festival Verden and World Breeding Dressage Championships for Young Horses

August 1 – 5, 2012

Three German horses at the top in the WC-qualification in Verden

(Verden) Sa Coeur is the name of the winner of the qualification for the World Breeding Dressage Championships of five-year-old dressage horses, and he inspired the judges to award a wide range of scores: The bay Oldenburg gelding was honoured with marks of 9 and better four times – 9.3 for his trot, 9.8 for his walk, 9 for submissiveness and 9.3 for overall impression. Eva Möller (Hagen a.T.W.) was more than happy and already hugged her Sa Coeur in the dressage ring....

Sa Coeur is an offspring by Sir Donnerhall – Don Davidoff, bred by the Gestüt Lewitz in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania and owned by the Hof Kasselmann KG. Paul Schockemöhle (Gestüt Lewitz) and his year-long business partner Ullrich Kasselmann will certainly be satisfied to hear about the victory. After all, three German horses dominated the qualification in the closely surrounded dressage arena in the WC-stadium. The Westphalian Revolverheld and the Rhinelander Lord Carnaby came in second and third behind Sa Coeur who impressed with his friendly composure and a final score of 9.18. Four Oldenburg horses finished among the top ten in the qualification for the WC-Final, one Hanoverian as well as horses from the Dutch breed and a Finish warmblood.

The Westphalian stallion Revolverheld by Landstreicher impressed with 9.5 for his walk and 9 for his canter. He was presented by Ann-Christin Wienkamp (Mesum) and managed to prevail (8,94) over the Rhineland chestnut stallion Lord Carnaby by Lord Loxley – Rocket Star (8.84) who was presented in Verden by Beatrice Buchwald (Dinslaken–Hiesfeld). The audience of the World Breeding Dressage Championships for Young Horses at the International Dressage and Show Jumping Festival in Verden can certainly look forward to these three horses – the 15 finalists in total will meet again in Verden on Saturday.
